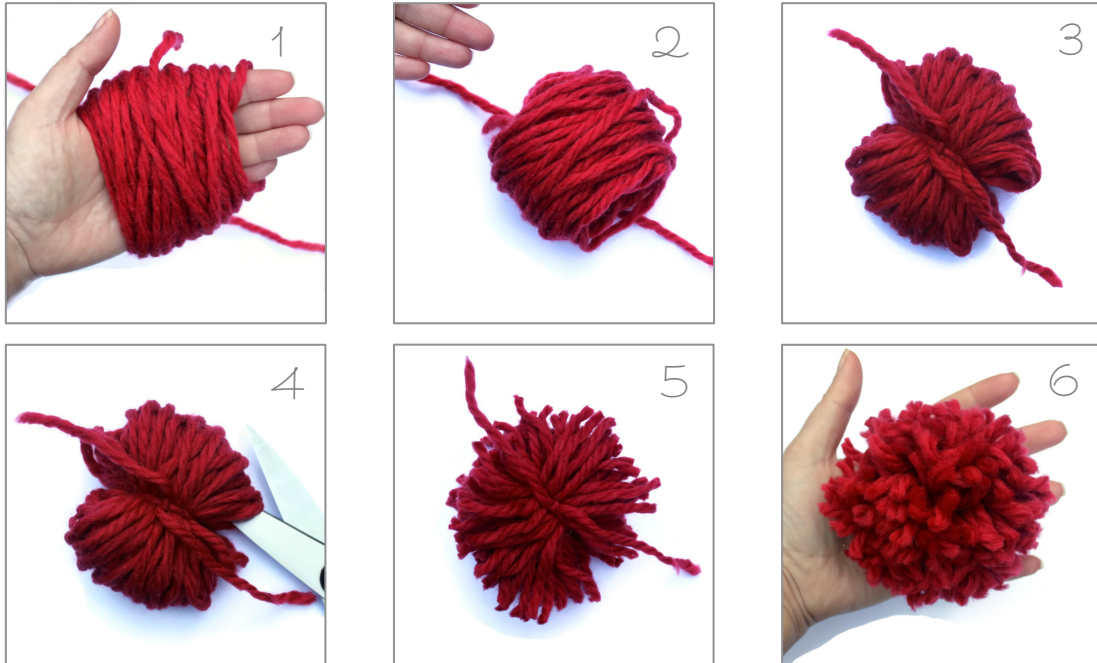


How to Make a Pom Pom by Hand



1. Cut a 20cm (7") length of yarn and lay it out straight on the table. (You'll see why at step 3 - both of your hands will be busy)
2. Wrap yarn around your hand approximately 60 times, more for an even fuller pom pom.
3. Carefully ease the wool from your hand and lay the loops on top of the 20cm (7") strand.
4. Tie the 20cm (7") firmly around the loops. Tie another knot or two just to be sure the yarn is securely tied.
5. Cut through the looped ends with scissors.
6. Fluff up the yarn and then give it a 'hair cut' or trim.
